## Cabin Leader Staph\*:

Cabin leaders will be expected to spend at least 6 hours per day doing camp-related activities which include (but will not be limited to):

1. Host daily cabin meetings at 9:30 PM EDT. Cabin leaders are responsible for creating and facilitating unique content and activities for these cabin meetings. The cabin leaders should work together to plan and facilitate cabin meetings and work with other cabin leaders.
2. Throughout the camp, cabin leaders will act as counselors for each of their assigned delegates. Delegates will be instructed to reach out to their cabin leaders for any help they might need with camp logistics, scheduling, technology troubleshooting, or concerns about camp or other delegates, presenters, or staph.
3. Engage regularly with delegates in Laura Dill's Porch and attend all of the nightly the lectures.
4. Help facilitate in real life (IRL) activities for delegates. Cabin leaders will help plan these IRL activities, encourage delegates to participate in the activities.
5. Create and send out press releases unique to each delegate to that delegate's local news outlets.
6. Offer at least two seminars during camp.
7. Attend assigned DS and seminar sessions for quality assurance, to take screen shots, and to troubleshoot as needed.
8. Be creative and collaborative in thinking of ways to engage delegates and encourage them to dedicate and set aside as much time as possible for the virtual camp.

Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until all positions are filled.

# Application Requirements

- NYSCamp Staph Application
- A Professional Style Headshot
- Resume
- Personal Statement
- Criminal Background Check – This will be completed after you have been offered a position on the staph, but your final hiring will be contingent upon a satisfactory report.

## Pay Scale

Base pay rate is \$65 per day. This daily rate is increased by the sum of the following increments to recognize education, training, and experience working in NYSFoundation programs:

- Education Increments (Single increase for highest attained):
  - Undergraduate Student:
    - Completed Freshman Year: Base Pay Rate
    - Completed Sophomore Year: \$2/day
    - Completed Junior Year: \$4/day
  - Bachelor's Degree or Equivalent: \$6/day
  - Graduate Student: \$8/day
  - Master's Degree or Equivalent: \$10/day
  - Doctorate: \$15/day
- Relevant Professional License/Certification:
  - Current Teaching License: \$3/day
  - Registered Nurse: Variable
  - Other: Variable
- Experience Increments:
  - \$1/day per year of NYSCamp Staph experience
  - \$0.50/day per year of WV GSMS Staph experience
  - \$0.50/day per year of WYSCamp Staph experience
- Positional Increments:
  - Additional increments may be assigned by the director to reflect program responsibilities.

If you have more than one degree at a particular level, you will be recognized at the next highest level. For example, if you have both a B.A. and a B.S. then you would receive the increment for having a Master's Degree. Please note that increments are not cumulative.

Example: A staph member who has worked 3 years at NYSCamp and 2 years at GSMS, and who holds a bachelor's degree and teaching certificate, would be paid \$78/day, which includes the \$65 base pay, plus \$6 bachelor's degree, plus \$3 teaching license, plus \$3 NYSCamp experience (3 X \$1), and plus \$1 GSMS experience (2 X \$0.50).
